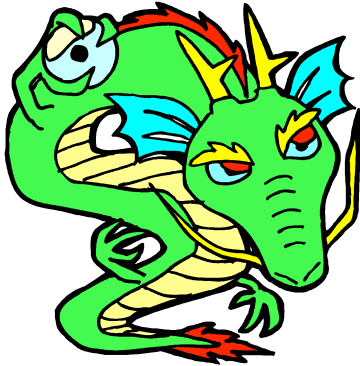

Spin words into your own magical story during this weeklong writing workshop with fellow-fans of fantastical worlds. of fantasy fiction. Students of this course will capture a world on the page that follows its own rules and invites readers to journey along. Imagination and a willingness to support each other will be necessary tools.

Carey Morton has lived and worked in Charlottesville since completing her Master's degree in Modern Irish Poetry at Wake Forest University in 1997. While she was an English teacher at Tandem Friends School, she cajoled and nudged students into discovering their individual writers' voices.
